Location: Bladen County North Carolina Grover Road, Tar Heel, NC 28392

From the intersection of Highway 87 and Tar Heel Road in Tar Heel, turn on Tar Heel Road and drive 1.51 miles to Chicken Foot Road. Turn right on Chicken Foot Road and drive 1.42 miles to Spring Branch Road. Turn right on Spring Branch Road and drive 2.17 miles to Grover Road. Turn right on Grover Road and drive .25 miles. The property is on the right. 34.763999 -78.830359
